 Meg Hickling R.N. explained that Sexual Health education is a life time project and she divided it into five stages.

Stage 1 - Preschool years, "Magical Thinking"; misinformation is dangerous for children.

Stage 2 - Primary to grade 3; "Mechanical Minds"; Lives are altered by lack of factual answers.

Stage 3 - Ages 8 - 14 years; most needy of accurate information. This is the most sexually abused age group. "Information equals Protection" from abusers.

 $\underline{\text{Stage 4}}$ - Teenagers; "They don't know what they don't know", lack of knowledge can lead to guilt problems.

Stage 5 - Sexual Mature; Adults (us!)
